### Fund update for the quarter ended 31 March 2021

This fund update was first made publicly available on 3 May 2021.

### What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Smartshares NZ Cash ETF has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Smartshares Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

### Description of this fund

Invests in New Zealand cash, with the objective of outperforming the S&P/NZX Bank Bills 90-Day Index over rolling 1-year periods.

### What are the risks of investing?

#### Risk indicator for the Smartshares NZ Cash ETF

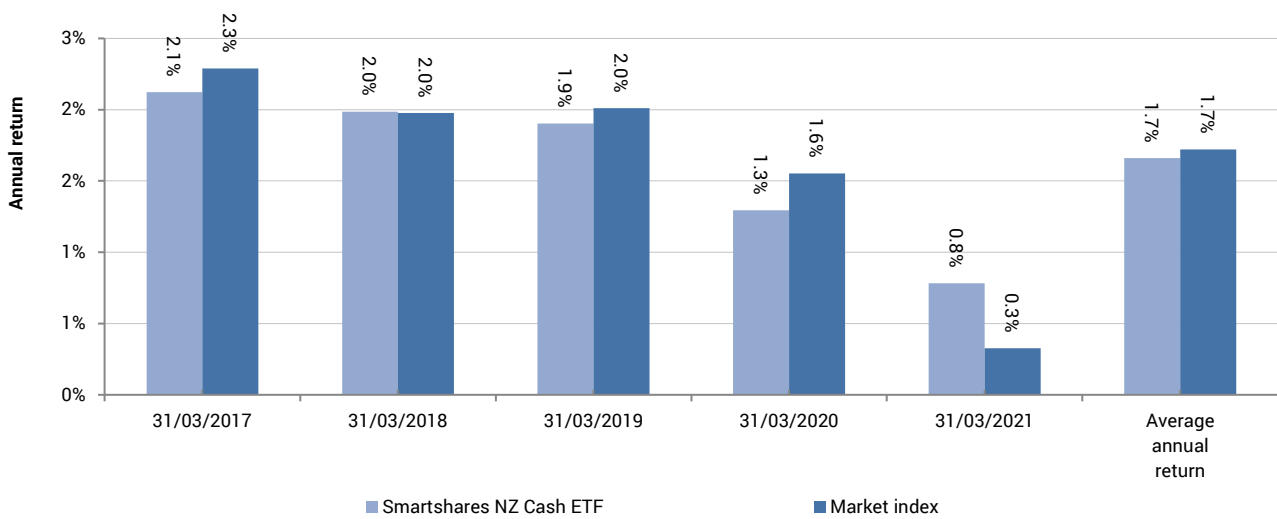

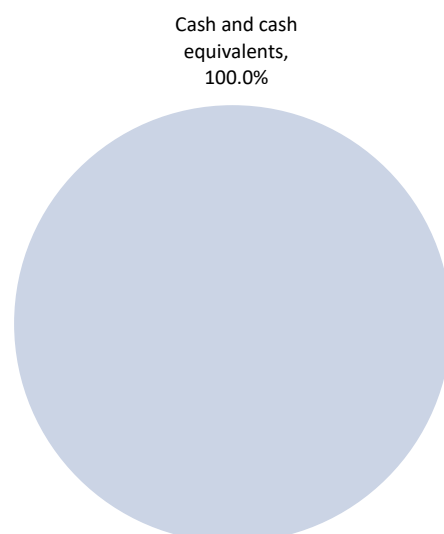
## Example of how this applies to an investor

Tara had \$10,000 in the fund and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Tara received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$78 (that is 0.78% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Tara a total return after tax of \$78 for the year.
