1. Primary listing fees in Q1 2022 includes deferred fees relating to prior year primary listings which are now recognised on the successful completion of contingency arrangements.

2. Participant services (net of internal revenue allocation) reduced in Q1 2022, due to the removal of derivatives trading and clearing participants annual membership fees as a result of the SGX partnership, plus the impact from a reduced number of market participants.

3. The global partnership to grow NZX's dairy derivatives market with the Singapore Exchange (SGX) went live in November 2021.

4. Consulting and development revenue for Q1 2021 included revenue for the development of the carbon managed auction service for the Ministry for the Environment which was completed in 2021.

5. Contractual revenue includes revenue from the ongoing operation of the carbon managed auction service provided for the Ministry for the Environment which commenced in March 2021.

6. Funds management revenue includes revenue from the ASB Superannuation Master Trust which was acquired on 11 February (FUM based revenue: \$459k; member based revenue: \$193k).
