PROXY FORM / ADMISSION CARD FOR VITAL LIMITED'S 2024 ANNUAL MEETING

Notice is given that the Annual Meeting of Vital Limited ("the Company") will be held at the Vital Office, Level 5, 25-27 Cambridge Terrace, Wellington and online at www.virtualmeeting.co.nz/vtl24 at **2:30pm on Tuesday, 22nd October 2024**. If you will attend the Meeting online, you will require your CSN/Holder Number for verification purposes.

If you will not attend the Meeting but wish to be represented by proxy, please complete and return this form (in accordance with the lodgment instructions above) to Vital's share registry, MUFG Corporate Markets (formerly Link Market Services), by no later than **2:30pm on Sunday 20th October 2024**.

You can also appoint your proxy and vote on the resolutions on the reverse of this form online by going to <https://investorcentre.linkgroup.nz/voting/VTL> or by scanning the QR code above with your smartphone.

Appointment of proxy

A proxy need not be a shareholder of Vital Limited. The Chairman of the Meeting is willing to act as a proxy. "Chairman of the Meeting" should be inserted as the name of your proxy on the reverse of this form if you wish the Chairman to act. A proxy will vote as directed in the proxy form or, if voting is left to the proxy's discretion, then the proxy will decide how to vote on the resolutions. If the Chairman is appointed as proxy and the voting is left to his discretion, the Chairman intends to vote in favour of all resolutions. If you do not name a person as your proxy but have indicated on this form how you wish to vote, the Chairman of the Meeting will vote in accordance with your express instructions.

Voting of your holding

If you appoint a proxy you must either direct the proxy how to vote by ticking the "For", "Against" or "Abstain" box in respect of each resolution OR by ticking the "Proxy Discretion" box in respect of each resolution. A shareholder can direct the proxy holder in respect of one or more resolutions and give the proxy holder discretion in respect of other resolutions. If you tick the "Proxy Discretion" box for a particular resolution, your proxy will decide how to vote that resolution. If you return this form without directing the proxy how to vote on any particular matter, the proxy may vote as he/she thinks fit or abstain from voting provided the proxy is eligible to vote on that matter. If a Director of the Company has been appointed as your proxy, the Director may vote in favour of the resolution, even if they have an interest in that resolution. If you make more than one election in respect of a resolution your vote will be invalid on that resolution.

Attending the meeting

If you wish to vote in person, you should attend the Meeting. **Please bring this form with you to the Meeting** to assist with your registration. The 2024 Annual Meeting will also be held online at www.virtualmeeting.co.nz/vtl24. If you will be attending online, you will require your Holder Number for verification purposes. A body corporate shareholder may appoint a representative to attend the meeting on its behalf. That person need not also be a shareholder.

Signing instructions for proxy forms

Individual

Where the holding is in one name, the shareholder must sign the Proxy Form.

Joint Holding

This Proxy Form may be signed by either, or on behalf of, the joint shareholders (or their duly authorised attorney). If the shareholder is a company, this Proxy Form must be signed on behalf of the company by a person acting under the company's express or implied authority.

Power of Attorney

If this Proxy Form has been signed under a power of attorney ("POA"), a copy of the POA (unless already noted by the company or its registry) and a signed certificate of non-revocation of the POA must be produced to the company with this form.

Corporate Shareholder

Any corporation that is a shareholder of the Company may appoint a person as its representative to attend the meeting and vote on its behalf, in the same manner as that in which it could appoint a proxy.
